Professional Career

Recognized for her work in painting, watercolor, drawing, engraving, and photography. She was also a teacher of painting and art history. In 2016, she served as Visual Arts Coordinator for the city of Porto Alegre, working at the Pinacoteca Ruben Berta. She was the creator and founder of AAPIPA – Association of Friends of Porto Alegre Art Galleries, established in 2016.

Education

Lou Borghetti studied painting with Danúbio Gonçalves, Fernando Baril, Renina Katz, Katie van Scherpenberg, Plínio Bernhardt, and Ana Tiscornia (Uruguay). Between 1973 and 1980, she regularly attended the Municipal Open Art Studio, where she studied wood carving under Anestor Tavares, sculpture under Claudio Martins Costa, drawing and lithography with Danúbio Gonçalves, and art theory and watercolor with Fayga Ostrower. She also studied and assisted in the studio of Iberê Camargo and later participated in the art workshop of Marco Túlio Resende in Belo Horizonte. Lou organized watercolor workshops at the Faculty of Fine Arts of the University of Seville (Spain) and at the Florence University of the Arts (Italy).
